



An insight into the Income Tax Bill, 2025

Parliament has recently introduced Income Tax Bill, 2025. Although the underlying law has substantively remained the same, there are subtle changes which go a long way and would have significant repercussions. In order to understand, learn, interpret and appreciate the nuances of this Bill, AIFTP has organised series of online lectures, to be delivered by some of the best in the field, covering substantive provisions of the Bill.
